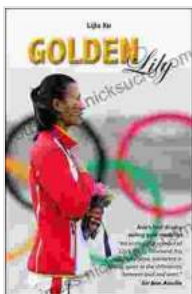


Asia First Dinghy Sailing Gold Medallist Making Waves

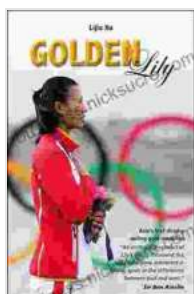

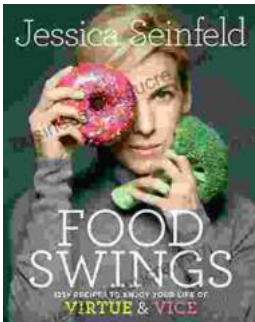
